The virus/ Covid 19	Educators Children Families Contractors Visitors	<p>We have hand sanitiser stationed across the centre to continually remind all persons entering our premises to clean their hands.</p> <p>Social distancing is encouraged,</p> <p>Markers to be positioned 1.5m apart for each family to stay on whilst checks are being done.</p> <p>Temperature checks are carried out throughout the service.</p> <p>Families are encouraged to drop off and pick up with only 1 person attending the service, to minimise any risk.</p> <p>Strict hygiene & Infection control will be implemented, including spraying and cleaning of Doors, windows, and other surfaces.</p> <p>Masks are available to families and educators. Any person entering the service over 12 years of age, is required to wear a mask.</p>
Contagions	Educators Children Families Contractors Visitors	<p>People with temperatures of more than 37.5 degrees are not permitted to be in the centre.</p> <p>Cleaning to be done regularly.</p> <p>Sanitiser to be used before entry. Educators and children are washing hands more regularly and social distancing to be practiced in the bathroom.</p>

		<p>Beds and eating spaces are to be spread out over larger area, 1.5m where possible. Educators are encouraged to complete the infectious control online course.</p> <p>Anyone presenting with any kind of illness are not to be on the premises Educators will closely monitor the health of children whilst in care. If a child develops any symptoms or becomes unwell during their day, they will need to be collected from care. No un-necessary people are to enter building. No incursions. Activities such as play dough, slime, goop or any other sensory experiences are not to be implemented to decrease the spread of germs and infections.</p>
		<p>Any person attending the service who has had a covid 19 test, must provide a copy of their results to management.</p>
